

靜宜大學校園整體規劃暨建築委員會設置辦法

Providence University Campus Planning and Architecture Committee Establishment Guidelines

Amended and approved in the University Council on January 15, 2018

Article 1: To ensure the aesthetic appeal and safety of the campus, and to conduct necessary reviews of building plans, Providence University has established the Campus Planning and Construction Committee (hereinafter referred to as the "Committee") to comprehensively plan the overall development of the campus.

Article 2: The duties of the Committee are as follows:

1. To provide recommendations and oversight on campus-wide building, landscaping development plans, and safety.
2. To review and evaluate various building projects on campus.

Article 3: The Committee shall be composed of the following members:

1. Ex officio members: The President or a Vice President designated by the President, the Dean of Academic Affairs, the Dean of Student Affairs, the Dean of General Affairs, and the Deans of each College.
2. Elected members:
 - Faculty representatives: Each college shall elect one representative, and the Center for General Education, the Physical Education Office, and the International College shall jointly elect one representative. The term of office is two years. Elected representatives must have served at the university for at least three years.
 - Staff representatives: Three representatives from the staff and technical personnel, with a term of two years. Elected representatives must have served at the university for at least three years.
 - Student representatives: Three representatives with a term of one year, elected by the Student Union.

Article 4: The Committee shall be convened by the President or a Vice President designated by the President. An Executive Secretary shall be appointed, who will be a secretary from the Office of General Affairs.

Article 5: The Committee may invite experts and scholars to attend its meetings.

Article 6: This regulation shall be implemented after approval by the University Council and promulgation by the President. The same procedure shall apply to any amendments.
