

## 靜宜大學原住民族學生資源中心設置辦法

# Regulations for the Establishment of Indigenous Student Resource Center at Providence University

Amended and approved in the administrative meeting on March 1, 2023.

Article 1 Providence University (hereinafter referred to as "the University") has established the "Indigenous Student Resource Center" (hereinafter referred to as "the Center") in accordance with the Indigenous Education Act to develop the diverse cultural characteristics of the campus, integrate internal and external resources, provide guidance to indigenous students, and enhance their learning effectiveness.

Article 2: The Center's tasks are as follows:

- (1) Indigenous student affairs and resource integration.
- (2) Adaptation and counseling for indigenous students' daily life.
- (3) Academic and learning guidance for indigenous students.
- (4) Cultural enrichment and development for indigenous students.
- (5) Emotional counseling and support for indigenous students.
- (6) Nurturing talent and promoting proactive learning for indigenous students.
- (7) Facilitating connections between indigenous students and their native tribal communities.
- (8) Providing and connecting resources for career planning.
- (9) Assisting in relevant courses and activities related to ethnic education.

Article 3 The Center should convene a consultation committee meeting at least once per semester. If necessary, it may call for ad hoc meetings and invite relevant individuals to attend or provide information.
