**Goals(SDGs) in the Post-Pandemic Era**

In the post-pandemic era, higher education institutions play a crucial role in responding to global challenges, including the United Nations' Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs). The goal of the Higher Education and UN SDGs Forum is to promote collaboration between higher education institutions, the United Nations, and other relevant stakeholders to achieve the SDGs by increasing awareness, fostering cooperation, and sharing best practices through research and innovation.

This forum invited scholars and professionals from five countries (Thailand, Myanmar, India, Cambodia, and Taiwan) to participate in a high-level discussion. The purpose was to enhance the understanding and awareness of SDGs within higher education institutions and the education sector. Participants shared insights and encouraged the integration of SDGs into teaching, research, and societal engagement. Additionally, they discussed ways to align SDGs with various industries.

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### 靜宜大學 管理學院

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管理學院目前共有企業管理學系、國際企業學系、會計學系、觀光學系、財務金融學系等五個學系(均含碩士班)，以及管理碩士在職專班、創新與創業管理碩士學位學程等，共七個學位。全院共有教師 100 位，學生人數近四千人。院下設「個案教學與研究中心」及「企業倫理教學與研究中心」等中心，以有效推動「倫理教育」及「實務與應用教學」。
