

Student Club Volunteer Services off Campus

Student clubs actively engage in community service by regularly visiting local elementary schools, communities, and organizations. They bring concepts of law and healthy living into everyday life through engaging team-building activities, dance, and music. By including interactive games that promote physical movement, they express care and foster emotional connections. These activities strengthen the bond between the university and the community, and are widely cherished by community members, reflecting the university's commitment to giving back to society.

During the 2023-2024 academic year, 16 student clubs, such as the Legal Service Club, Hip-Hop Dance Club, Chinese Orchestra, Guitar Club, and Wind Band, actively engaged in community service at local elementary schools, communities, and organizations in the Miaoli, Nantou, and Taichung regions. Altogether, they carried out 90 service activities, involving 603 volunteers and serving 1,375 individuals.
