PU collaborates with the Labor Affairs Bureau of Taichung City Government to establish the College to encourage our labor friends to enhance their knowledge and skills through continuing education while working. The courses covering various subjects such as industrial development and technical enhancement, digital information application, management, labor rights protection, and industry/workplace professional language are available.

PU's Labor College primarily serves laborers in the central coastal region of Taiwan. It aims to bridge the urban-rural gap by providing vocational skills training and hosting public lecture. In 2023-2024 academic year, a total of 9 courses and 3 lectures were conducted.
